- 2. Map A (Boundary): write your initials and today's date in the box to confirm the red outline shows the land you have used for lawful sports and pastimes.
- 3. Map B (Neighbourhood): place an X where your home is; add your initials and today's date.
- 4. Written statement: please complete in your own words

- 3. Remember to complete the questionnaire, the written statement, as well as Map A and Map B.
